



New Mexico Out-of-State Tuition Waiver Application

Out of state tuition fee waivers are available on a limited basis to New Mexico students attending EAC.

- New Mexico tuition waivers may be renewable up to a maximum of three semesters after the original award has been made for a total of four semesters.
- To renew a New Mexico Tuition Waiver, students must complete at least 12 credits per semester and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above.
- For priority consideration, your application should be postmarked on or before March 1.
- To be eligible for consideration, you **must**:

√ Provide proof of New Mexico Residency by submitting one (1) valid supporting document:

- High school transcript or diploma
- Drivers license
- Motor vehicle registration
- State income tax return for previous year
- Property ownership document
- Dependency status indicated on your parent's federal income tax return from previous year
- Bank statement addressed to your state of residency

√ Provide a copy of your most recent high school transcript reflecting a GPA of 2.0 or higher.

√ Be registered for classes at Eastern Arizona College for the semester in which you are applying.
