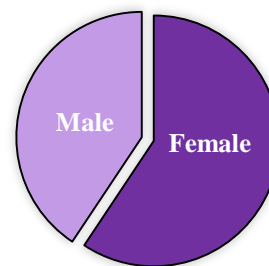

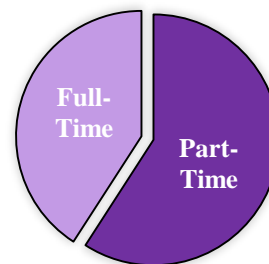

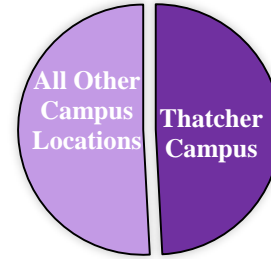


Full-Time Versus Part-Time Students	Enrollment	Percentage

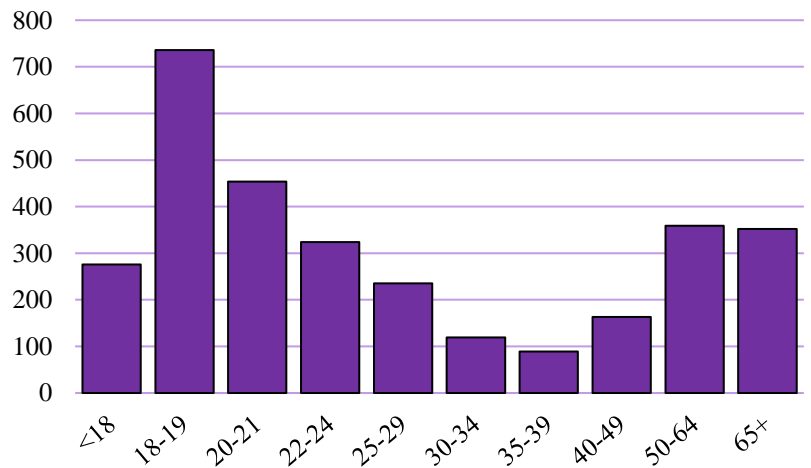
Campus Location

All Other Campus Locations.....	3213	50.8%



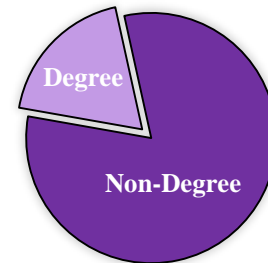
