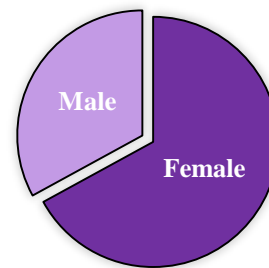

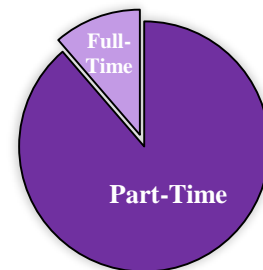

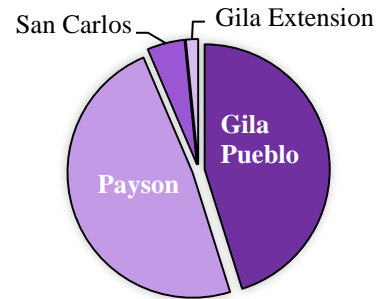


Full-Time Versus Part-Time Students	Enrollment	Percentage

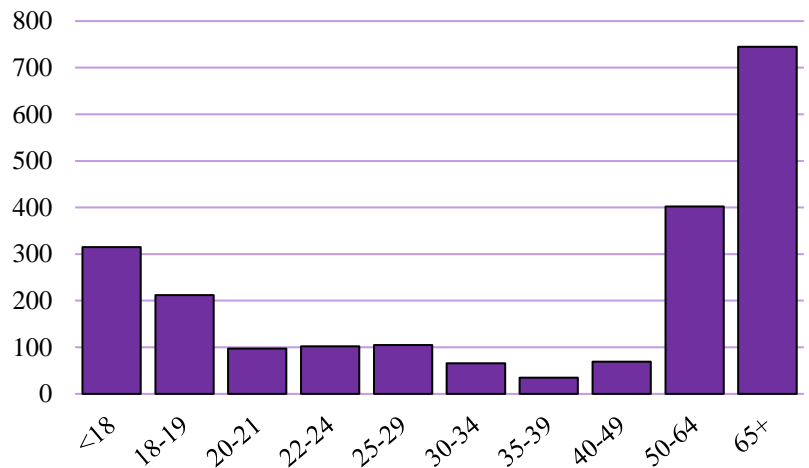

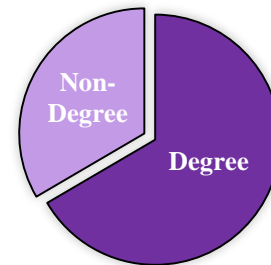
