

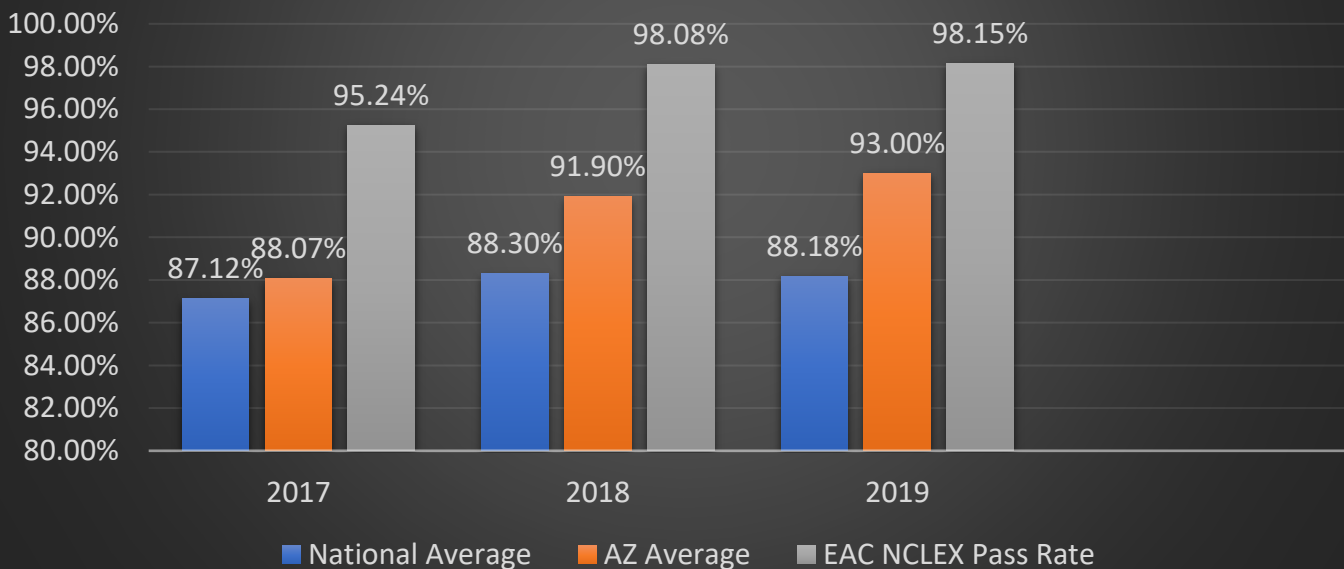


# Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing Program Outcomes

ELA: The most recent annual pass rate will be at least 80% for all first-time test-takers from January 1 to December 31 every year.

**ELA: Annual performance on the certification examination (NCLEX-RN) for all first-time test-takers during the same 12-month period.**

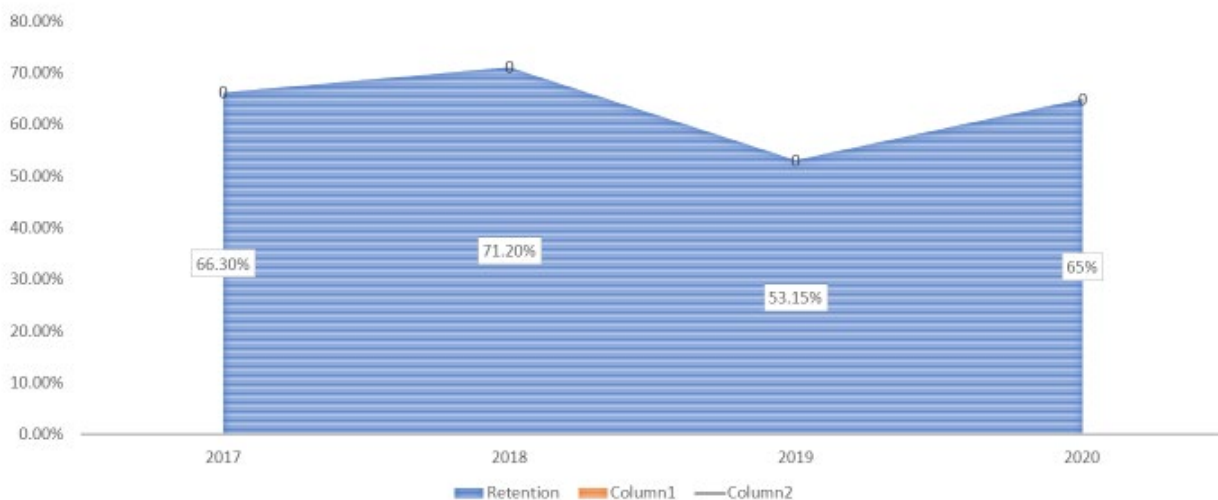


## Program Completion Rate:

ELA: 65% of all students that begin in the first nursing course, after acceptance into the program, will complete the program within 6 semesters, which is 150% of the usual timeframe for the nursing program.

Action plan in place for program completion. Added additional faculty, program start entry for all semesters on the Gila campuses. We moved content in curriculum from one semester to another—added nursing student tutoring; among other initiatives.

ELA: 90% of all graduate respondents will report employment as registered nurses within twelve months of graduation.
