Online: Register over the Internet using Gila Hank Online, EAC's real-time registration system. Go to www.eac.edu and click the Gila Hank Online link. Walk-in: Records and Registration Office, Student Services Building, weekdays 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

- To use Gila Hank Online (www.eac.edu), you need to sign in to your account using your EAC Student ID and your Monster ID provided by the Admissions or Records and Registration Office. If you did not receive your Monster ID, call (928) 428-8270. When logging in for the first time, use your Student ID as your password. You will be prompted to change your password. After your first visit, use your Monster ID and password for future login.
