

# NURSING ASSISTANT CERTIFICATE 30706

Students are not required to complete all courses in this certificate to be eligible to test with the Arizona State Board of Nursing to receive their Licensed Nursing Assistant or Certified Nursing Assistant credential. The completion of only NUR 100 Nursing Assistant course will allow the student to be eligible to test and apply to the Arizona State Board of Nursing.
