One of the courses taken to fulfill degree requirements must be designated as an Intensive Writing/Critical Inquiry (IW) course and another must be designated as a Global/International/Historical Awareness (GIH) course. FRE/SPA 101, FRE/SPA 102, FRE/SPA 201 and FRE/SPA 202 all complete the GIH course requirement.
