2. If student is considering transferring to ASU and wants to be admitted as a major upon arrival, you are expected to complete either MAT160 or PSY220 - an Introduction to Statistics course. You may use this course as your math requirement.
3. Students are strongly encouraged to work with the academic advisor for this major in the selection of electives that will transfer and complement their future studies in Communication or another field.
