

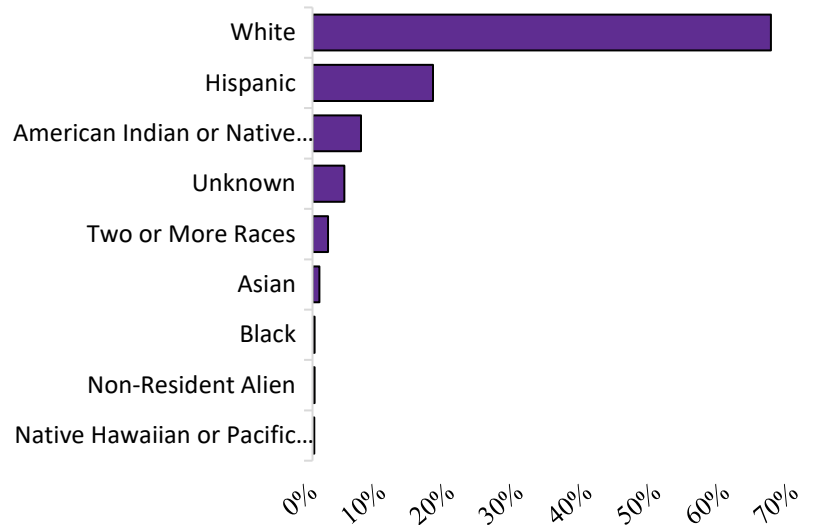

Gila Community College Provisional District Student Profile Fall 2021

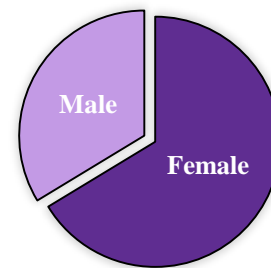

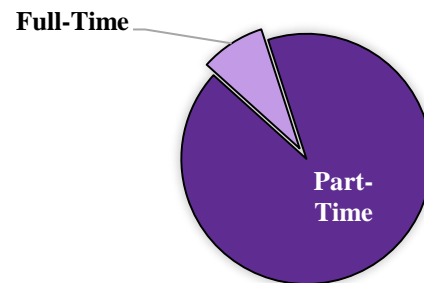

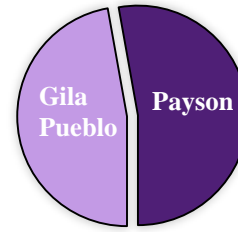


Full-Time Versus Part-Time Students	Enrollment	Percentage

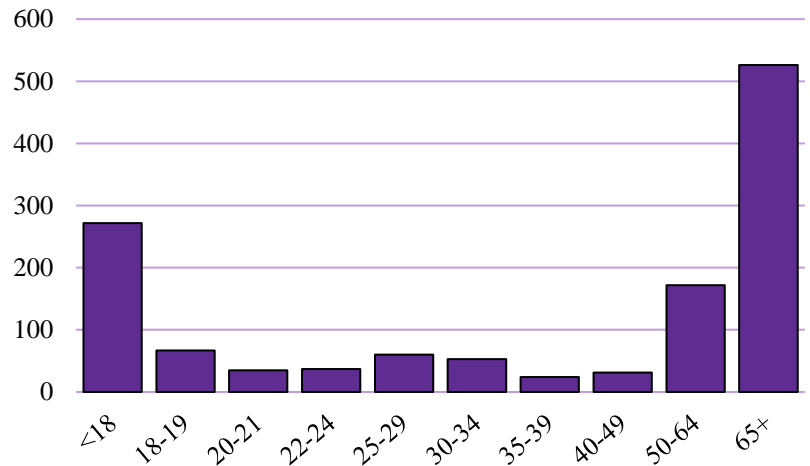

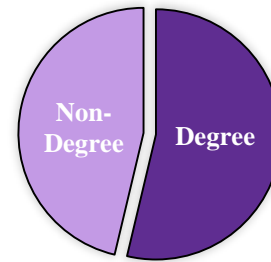
