#### What is FERPA

- Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act
- Federal law that details requirements regarding privacy of student records
- Broad Requirements:
  - Release, or not, of education records
  - Student access to their records

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99)

# FERPA provides certain rights to students;

- the right to inspect and review their education records
- the right to request to have their education records amended,
- and, the right to have some control over the disclosure of personally identifiable information form their education records.
  - ➤ Education Records those records that are directly related to a student maintained by an institution.
  - ➤ College Student a person who is or has been in attendance at a post-secondary institution (taken any class offered).



### Parental Rights





Parents have the right to act on behalf of a dependent student in limited situations.



EAC is post-secondary education; therefore, all students (even under the age of 18) have the three rights stated previously.



Our practice – never disclose student education record information, of any kind, to anyone other than the student.



When in doubt – do not give it out.



# Education Records

- Education records contain information directly related to a student by which the student may be identified.
- <u>Directory Information</u> information not generally considered a violation of a student's privacy.
- Non-Directory Information any student information not stated as directory information and generally considered to be personal and confidential.

### **EAC Student Directory Information**

- Category I Name, address, telephone number(s), email address, dates of attendance, class and picture.
- Category II Previous institutions attended, major fields of study, awards, honors (includes Dean's List), degrees conferred (including dates).
- Category III Past and present participation in officially recognized sports and activities, physical factors (height and weight of athletes), date and place of birth.
- Students have the right to withhold disclosure of any category of directory information.
- Requests by anyone other than the student for any student information are best directed to Records and Registration.
- When in doubt do not give it out.





## Important Reminders

- Many types of student record information are considered personal, sensitive, and confidential.
- Verify student identity every time you disclose student information to ensure you only disclose information to the student it pertains to.
- Be careful and vigilant when working with education record data; security measures should always be employed when devolving, storing, or disclosing student data.
- Be cautious with any request for student information from anyone other than the student.
- If presented with written authorization from someone other than the student, contact Records and Registration.
- When in doubt do not give it out; contact Records and Registration for direction.
