The needs and nature of education at the community college level move with exceptional rapidity. It shall be the policy of the District Governing Board to utilize on a planned basis the means available for keeping the District Governing Board members abreast of the progress of the College and of new needs and practices. To accomplish this purpose, the District Governing Board recognizes the need for special study meetings where discussion may take place about the philosophy of the College, an evaluation of progress toward the goals of the College, innovations proposed by the staff or used elsewhere or reports submitted periodically by the College President and/or personnel designated by the College President.

The College President shall be responsible for recommending to the District Governing Board:

1. Books and magazine articles and reports that are of particular pertinence.
2. Reports and publications from the College or studies by the staff or faculty with which the District Governing Board should be familiar.
3. The work of comparable colleges elsewhere in which new practices are of such significance to warrant visitation by District Governing Board and/or staff members.
4. Consultants who may confer with District Governing Board and staff on particularly significant areas.
