Campus Security shall be governed by the philosophy and principles of the College.

Campus Security shall be staffed by certified peace officers and other campus security personnel.

Campus Security has three major responsibilities:

- B. To investigate and deal with infractions of the law and College regulations.
- C. To protect and make secure physical facilities.

The main emphasis of Campus Security shall be that of prevention of:

- A. Accidents
- B. Destruction
- C. Fire
- D. Crime
- E. Situations that create ill will and anger
- F. Unrest and violence
- G. Situations that might lead to student arrests, jail sentences and suspension from College
