The Arizona Revised Statutes, Section 15, Chapter 12 as amended provides for the powers and duties of community college districts and their governing boards.

Title to all real property financed by public funds is vested in the District Governing Board and sale or disposal of such property must have its prior approval.

The District Governing Board is charged with the responsibility of approving all college plans, programs, budgets, and facilities; setting standards; and issuing ordinances, rules, and regulations for the conduct of the college.

The Graham County Treasurer is the fiscal agent for all state funds allocated to the GCCCD. The County Board of Supervisors is responsible for securing current tax support for the District when such has the approval of the District Governing Board.

For revenue producing buildings requested by the District Governing Board, the institution may accept grants or loans of money from a federal agency and borrow money and issue revenue bonds and provide for payment of the same. Such bonds may not constitute an obligation of the State of Arizona.

Additional support from public funds for approved operational and capital purposes is the responsibility of the Graham County Community College District.
