Each residence hall room at Eastern Arizona College is under the joint control of the College and the student or students residing in the room. Students are required to abide by all rules and regulations contained in the Residence Life Handbook, the Residence Hall Application and License Agreement, and the Residence Hall Check In/Out Sheet and Regulations. If a student has any questions about any rules and regulations, he or she should contact the Head Resident or Housing Office.

The College reserves the right to enter any residence hall room at any time, with or without prior notice, for the purpose of inspection for cleanliness, safety, need for repairs or maintenance, and/or compliance with the policies and rules of the College and Residence Halls. By submitting an application requesting placement in student housing, the student is considered to have agreed to such inspections.

Room inspections normally will be conducted by the Head Resident, Hall Assistants, Head Resident’s designee or Chief Housing Officer. If such an inspection reveals the existence of unlawful items, or items that indicate that criminal activity has or may be occurring, the Head Resident should contact Campus Police for assistance. If such inspection reveals evidence of a violation of school policy or rule, other than criminal misconduct, the Chief Student Officer or his or her designee should be contacted.
