Every student, faculty member, and visitor shall wear appropriate protective eyewear while participating in or when observing vocational, technical, industrial arts, art, or laboratory science activities involving exposure to:

1. Molten metals or other molten materials.
2. Cutting, shaping, and grinding materials.
3. Heat treatment, tempering, or kiln firing of any metal or other materials.
4. Welding fabrication processes.
5. Explosive materials.
6. Caustic solutions.
7. Radioactive materials.

GCCCD shall provide appropriate non-prescriptive safety glasses/goggles or other protective eyewear for students, faculty, and visitors when observing these described activities. It shall be the duty of the area or class supervisor to distribute and require usage under the described circumstances or to deny access to the area.

For purposes of this regulation, “Protective Eyewear” means devices meeting the standards of the American National Standards Institute’s standards for occupational and education eye protection, Z87.1-1989.
