A cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher.

Academic Probation

If an enrolled student's cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) after attempting 12 or more credits in either the fall or spring semester falls below 2.0, the student will be placed on academic probation. In the subsequent fall or spring semester, the student will be allowed to register for no more than sixteen (16) credits.

Extended Academic Probation

At the end of the academic probation semester, if the student fails to raise his/her GPA to 2.0 or higher, the student will be placed on extended academic probation. While on extended academic probation, the student will be limited to seven (7) credit hours in subsequent semesters and summer sessions until the student's GPA is 2.0 or higher.

Appeal of Academic Probation or Extended Academic Probation

If a student believes he/she was placed on academic probation or extended academic probation as a result of extenuating circumstances, the student may petition the Academic Standards Appeals Committee for an exception.
