Academic Progress

1. Official transcripts of all previous college level work for full-time students who want to receive credit for prior college work or who need to show that prerequisites have been satisfied or athletes needing to prove eligibility should be on file in the Admissions and Records Office, no later than the close of registration.
2. Students registered for 12 or more units at the close of registration must successfully compile a GPA of 2.00 or better. (Exception: Official withdrawal from all classes may negate this provision.)

Veterans or Eligible Persons Receiving V.A. Benefits--Standards

1. Each eligible person will be required to successfully compile a GPA of 2.000 or better.
2. At the end of each semester, eligible persons who have not compiled a GPA of 2.000 or better will be placed on academic probation. They will be provided an opportunity to improve their academic progress by re-enrolling in the next term and receive educational benefits. If at the end of the succeeding semester an eligible person does not meet the "Standards of Academic Progress" for that term, that person may continue in school; but the Veteran's Affairs Office of the College will not certify the student for further Veteran's Administration benefits.
