EAC Placement Testing

Students will be required to complete a placement test prior to registration if any one of the following conditions applies:

- The student is taking his or her first college credit English, reading and/or math course or any college course for which an English, reading, or math course or placement score is a prerequisite. An EAC Score in reading of 60 or higher is required for most General Education courses that list an appropriate reading score as a prerequisite.
- The student is pursuing a degree and does not have current valid EAC approved course placement scores on file or does not have previous college credit in English, reading, or math.

Students may be exempt from a placement test if at least one of the following conditions applies:

- The student has earned an associate or higher degree and brings documentation to support this.
- The student has earned college level credits from an accredited college or university in English, reading and/or math with a grade of “C” or higher.
- The student has submitted proof of acceptable ACT, SAT, Compass, or Accuplacer test scores for placement into college level courses.

EAC accepts official score reports from ACT, SAT, Accuplacer and Compass scores for placement into college courses. Contact the Testing Office at (928)428-8491 or email testing.center@eac.edu if you have completed placement tests that differ from this list.

Students may retest once after 24 hours. Subsequent retests may be taken after 30 days. Remediation is strongly encouraged before a student retests.

- (Raw) Placement scores are converted to an EAC Score, so the score located on the Score Report you receive may not be the same score that appears in the EAC system.
- Cut scores for placement have been determined by a collaboration of Testing personnel, Language Arts and Mathematics department chairs.
- Final placements in Reading, English Composition and Mathematics courses will be determined by the placement system using scores and other information supplied by the student.
