October has shown a lot of progress for both Cosmo and Grey Shell. The exterior EIFS systems are complete and the masonry veneer has started going up on Cosmo. The storefronts and curtain walls have been steadily coming along as well. Inside the buildings, we are closing up walls in Cosmo and finishing up any remaining rough in for electrical and special systems. The water supply pipes have passed testing and we are gearing up to turn on power in the coming month. The RMC Clinic is coming into shape as we have started the interior framing.

Right along side it, overhead rough in for mechanical and plumbing are off to a great start. On the site, backfill is nearly complete for the retention tanks and we have installed all underground conduit running to the new transformer, along with the conduit to each building's respective switchgear units.
