ⁱⁱ Retention refers to CTE concentrators who remain enrolled in postsecondary education or advanced training, enter military service, volunteer in a national service program that receives assistance through the National and Community Service Act of 1990 or the Peace Corps, or were employed.

ⁱⁱⁱ These are CTE concentrators who attained a recognized postsecondary certificate, degree, or credential during participation in a CTE program or within one year of program completion.

^{iv} Nontraditional programs are those in which individuals from a single gender comprise less than 25% of the individuals employed in the related occupation or field of work.
