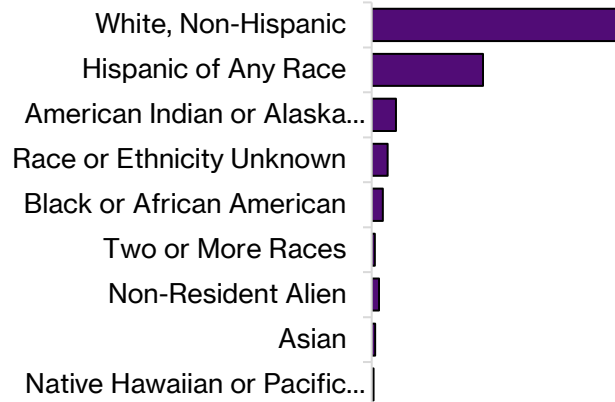

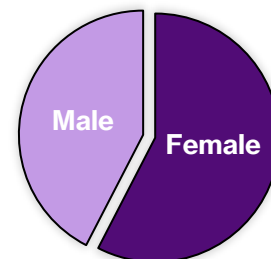

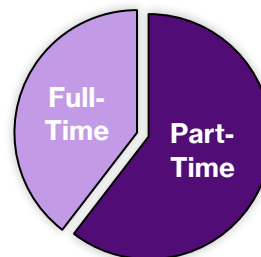

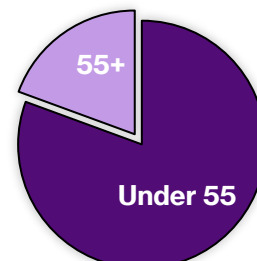
Enrollment Status

Senior Citizen Tuition

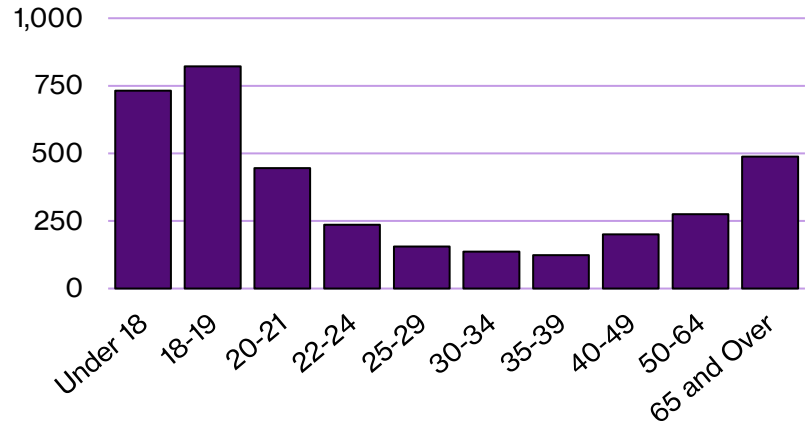

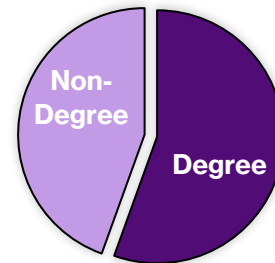
